## >> WYnet Trips

**Just as you sent me into the world, I am sending them into the world.** John 17:18 (NLT)

Jesus came to earth and lived as an example among real people; he taught them; he showed them who God was and how much God loves the world. WYnet exists to aid Wycliffe Bible Translators in the same mission: to show people who God is and how much He loves the World. We believe the best way to

achieve this is by giving people God's Word, His story of love for everyone in the language they understand best.

This trip to Togo provides the opportunity to observe, experience, learn from, pray for and help a community gaining access to God's Word in the language they understand best.

## >> What is involved?

People need to hear God's story.

Imagine not having the Bible in a language you can understand! That's the situation for over 2,200 languages and 353 million people today. Bible translation enables such people to hear of God's love for them in their own language. There is much involved in a Bible translation project, and we aim to show you both the work that goes into it, and also the people and churches who benefit.

On this trip to Togo, you may:

- do some language learning
- live in a village
- learn about living cross-culturally
- see the translators at work
- visit local churches
- promote use of translated Scriptures in church and community
- Learn more about God and His mission

## >> The details



1st –25th July 2010 a team made up of 16-18 year olds and 3 WYnet Leaders, will visit Togo (west Africa).

The trip begins with 3 days of orientation in the UK, followed by 3 weeks in Togo. A debrief will take place on the last day in Togo to consider and evaluate what the team experienced.

Between them the leaders have good knowledge of Togo and experience of running short-term trips.

- a committed Christian, actively involved in a local church?
- aged 16+ or finishing your GCSEs this year?
- physically fit?
- ready for a new experience?
- willing to engage with a new culture?

## >> The cost?

Costs vary each year. However we anticipate that the overall cost will be approximately £1,600.

This includes the cost of the orientation days, your flights from London, visas, housing, food, and travel insurance. This will all be arranged on your behalf by WYnet.

You are responsible to carry the cost of any vaccinations and/or medication required for your trip. You must also provide your own spending money for snacks and souvenirs.
